China Gansu Education Program

We are collaborating with Cedar Fund (Hong Kong, China) to assist women to attend basic education and development programs in remote villages of China.

Gansu Province, China, is one of the poorest inland provinces, and has received the least amount of external support. Since 2003, Cedar Fund has been working closely with the local Lanzhou Christian Church Council (LZCCC) on women education and development program in the outskirts of Lanzhou, Gansu Province.



CEDAR has finished teaching thirty-two classes, benefiting a thousand women directly. Based on previous success, we are expanding to assist more women in other villages in Gansu Province. Our program is designed to teach students basic literacy skills in a classroom study, followed by a personal development program to teach farming techniques, social skills, health, and personal hygiene. These programs show them how to take a more active role in their own development, improve their social status, and make an impact in their communities.

Central Asia Kyrgyzstan Education Program

Kyrgyzstan is a remote country in Central Asia, neighboring China, Russia, and Kazakhstan. We are collaborating with the Mercy Foundation and Central Asia Sharing Aid (CASA) to bring hope to needy children.

Since the year 2000, they have established elementary schools, middle schools, schools for the disabled, orphanages, vocational schools, and brought love to more than 1,200 children. The schools are: School at Belovodsk (1-11 grade, 240 students), School at Kara-Balta (1-9 grade, 260 students),



Children Home at Kara-Balta (shelter 80 students), School at Tokmok (1-9 grade, 224 students), School at Ivanovka (1-8 grade, 176 students), Home and School for Disable at Kemin (70 students), Children Home at Tokmok (50 students), Children playground, swimming pool, and NBA-size gymnasium at Tokmok

We hand pick these students from the financially needy families, provide them with the basic needs, including food, clothing, shelter, and health care, and bring them up with proper education and spiritual growth.

West Africa Ghana Education Program

We are collaborating with the River of Life Christian Church (ROLCC) in Santa Clara, California and the local ROLCC churches to build schools in Ghana, west-coast Africa.

In 2005, the local Ghana ROLCC church built a new elementary school, New Life Academy, near the heart of Accra, Ghana. This school now offers classes to 250+ children from first to eighth grade, teaching courses in Math, English, History, Art, Drama, Poetry and Music. We are building new school buildings and expanding our programs.



Students are from poor villages in the neighborhood, and parents make various sacrifices to send their children to our school in hopes of letting their children achieve a better future. We are supporting the school to start a new scholarship program, so that students can attend school regardless of their financial situations. We are planning on a new computer lab so that students can learn important computer skills, have a quality education, and have the possibility of attending college one day.
